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Training Contract

J.S. Kennels & Training, LLC is closed Sundays. Training is Monday through Saturday and all business at our facility is done by appointment only. You may call to check on the progress of your dog at any time, but remember that we may not always answer the telephone because most of our time is spent training dogs. Please leave a voicemail and we will return your call. It is our policy to return calls within 48 hours of receipt. If we don't we didn't receive a message due to service.

I, _____ (client) engage the services of Jason Staley of J.S. Kennels & Training ("Trainer") for the purpose of dog training, _____, Dog(s) which will be trained by the trainer until client or trainer deem training should be terminated.

TRAINING FEE: Client shall pay the training fees and cost as set forth on the attached fee schedule. The first months training fee is due at the signing of this agreement. Payment of monthly fees is due on or before the 15th day of each month for the previous month. In return for the payment, trainer will train the clients dog(s) listed above. Cost of feed, Nu-vet, Glycocharge, Heartworm preventive, wormer, are not included. (Price only includes: training, birds, and flea tick preventative). Other expenses may include but are not limited to, veterinary care, travel to and from the vet, travel to or from the airport, baths, grooming, horse fees, handling at field trials, and/or travel to and from field trials.

FIELD TRIAL FEES: Field trial training is incorporated into the daily training routine of the trainer if the client requests and agrees that the dog(s) participate in field trial events under the handling of the Trainer. If the client request field trial training the following will apply: Client will pay all entry fees and handling fees no later than 7 business days prior to J.S. Kennels leaving for the circuit. Also, handling fees to Jason Staley will match the entry fee of the dog.



VETERINARY CARE: The Trainer will, on a regular basis, inspect the dog for injury and illness. Proper veterinary care will be sought in the case that the trainer deems it necessary. The Client authorizes the Trainer to obtain any necessary vet care by signing this agreement and agrees to reimburse trainer for all amounts charged by the vet, plus pay the trainer a \$25.00 (per visit) vet visit transportation fee. Payment of these fees and cost will be due within 2 weeks of the veterinarian visit.

UPON ARRIVAL: When leaving my dog(s) at J.S. Kennels and Training, these guidelines will be followed:

- Client will arrive at the *scheduled time* as other appointments and training are scheduled around Clients appointment. (Most importantly, all appointments are scheduled for the optimum and safest work time as the heat of the day can affect both the dog's performance and health.)
- Clients dog(s) must be on a leash when out of the vehicle.
- Some dogs can accept a great deal of training in 30 days, others are just getting started. The average adult dog needs 6 months of intensive training to be a proficient gun dog. If I leave my dog for less time, I do not expect a fully trained dog. Obedience training may take less time dependent upon what the Client expects to get done and dependent upon how diligent Client is with the follow up at home.
- When Client comes to pick up his/her dog, Client will expect to spend the time the Trainer feels is necessary for client to learn the techniques that the dog and the Trainer have used so that Client will have the skills to follow through on the training.

The following is required before or upon arrival of your dog(s) at J.S. Kennels & Training:

Proof of shots- distemper, hepatitis, parainfluenza, canine parvovirus, coronavirus, and bordetella (kennel cough).

DEFAULT: In the event the Client fails to pay the fees and cost as set forth in this agreement, the Trainer shall have a lien in the dog as set forth in Idaho Code (s45-8051a). Trainer shall be entitled to foreclose such lien in client's dog to collect the fee and cost owed to Trainer. Trainer shall be entitled to its attorney fees and cost incurred to collect its fees. If fees are not paid for a period of 60 days, ownership of the dog will be forfeited, and the dog will go up for sale to cover the amount of the bill. Also, the client will be obligated by this contract to transfer all ownership documentation and registrations to the trainer. If legal action is required to obtain proper ownership documentation, the client will be bound by this contract to pay attorney's fees and court cost incurred by the trainer to obtain ownership transfer.



HOLD HARMLESS: The client agrees to hold Trainer harmless from any and all claims, liability, loss, damage, or expense arising out of any injury to any person or to any person's property by the dog(s) described in this agreement, while in the custody, care, and control of Trainer.

LIABILITY LIMITATION: The client acknowledges that dog training will not provide exact results. Each dog is different regarding intelligence, ability, and temperament. Trainer makes no guarantee of the results reached in training or to the level of competency reached by contracted dog(s).

-Trainer reserves the right to terminate this training contract at any time, and to request that the Client pick up his/her dog(s). All pre-paid training fees will be refunded on a daily pro-rated basis in the event that Trainer makes such a request.

The client accepts that this is a training contract and that Trainer is not an insurer of the condition of the dog(s) while in the Trainers custody.

-Trainer shall have no liability for the cost of replacing any contracted dog(s) or for any damage of any kind, should contracted dog(s) die, escape, be stolen, become ill, or become injured while in the care of Trainer.

-All dogs in boarding and training with Trainer are treated with the utmost care and respect. Proper care will be given and generally accepted training methods will be followed while the dog(s) is/are under contract. Dog training can be dangerous and injury or death can occur to the dog(s), even when careful measures have been taken.

-Client understands that the results of training depend in large part on the capabilities of Client's dog(s) and results are not guaranteed. Client understands the risk involved for his/her dog while training and while being boarded with Trainer. Client understands that it is possible for dogs to sustain injuries causing permanent damage and even resulting in death while training or being boarded. Client will not hold responsible in any way should client dog become ill, get injured, or die while in the care of Trainer.

-Client understands that when this contract refers to J.S. Kennels and Training, LLC, it includes Jason Staley or any person, property, or device, owned by, associated with, or being used by J.S. Kennels and Training, LLC.

SOLE AGREEMENT: This contract is the sole agreement between the Trainer and Client. Any prior agreements, negotiations, or promises not expressed in this contract are no longer in force or effect. Exceptions will be agreed upon and listed below.



OTHER AGREEMENTS:

JURISDICTION AND VENUE: The terms and provisions of this agreement shall be governed by the laws of the state of Idaho. Furthermore, the undersigned consents to and agrees that the jurisdiction and venue of any disputes arising under this agreement shall be with the fifth Judicial District Court of Idaho in Twin Falls County Idaho.

ATTORNEY FEES: In the event there is a dispute under this agreement between and among the parties here to the prevailing party shall be awarded its reasonable attorney fees and cost.
